Adolescent School Health Physician Responsibilities:

- Improve the health of school children through clinical and public health work
- Support the development and implementation of medical initiatives that promote positive health behaviors and outcomes in the adolescent population
- Reduce high risk behaviors
- Provide medical care and public health services to adolescents through Office of School Health programs and initiatives
- Work with the innovative Connecting Adolescents to Comprehensive Health Care (CATCH) Program, which provides select reproductive health services to adolescents in select NYC high schools.
- Serve as a consultant to the school nurse and administration on school health related concerns
- Provide clinical assistance in the event of an environmental or communicable disease occurrence

Physicians who have completed residency training in the following are also encouraged to apply: Preventive Medicine, Social Pediatrics, Adolescent Medicine, Community Medicine, Family Practice, or Med-Peds. Training in community health or public health a plus. 10- or 12-month assignments are available.
